The association serves as a central hub for promoting the learning and teaching of Thai language and culture throughout the country.



Our Objectives

- To promote the teaching and learning of Thai language and culture throughout Switzerland.
- To develop knowledge and understanding of effective teaching methods for Thai language and culture.
- To support volunteer teachers in conducting teaching activities efficiently.
- To foster a sense of community and unity among volunteer Thai language teachers.
- To provide a platform for teachers to exchange knowledge and teaching experiences.

The "Sawasdee" Thai Language and Culture Curriculum

This curriculum is divided into three levels, designed to provide a comprehensive learning path for students abroad.

Beginner Level (Years 1-2)

- Build foundational listening and speaking skills using familiar topics like colors, body parts, and family.
- Learn the Thai alphabet (ກ-ອ) and basic vocabulary through engaging activities.

Intermediate Level (Years 3-4)

- Practice fundamental reading and writing, starting with simple vowels (າ, ຖ, ອີ).
- Advance to more complex vowels, the three consonant classes (Triyang), and tone marks.

Advanced Level (Years 5-6)

- Read lessons and stories about Thailand.
- Master advanced spelling rules (Ma-tra Tua Sa-kod), changing and reduced vowels, consonant clusters, the Ror-Han symbol (ຮຮ), and silent letters (Tua Karan).

This curriculum is designed to help Thai children abroad learn in a joyful and engaging way, leading to a true and genuine understanding of the Thai language!
